



NICOLA LAW (Feature: 1742)

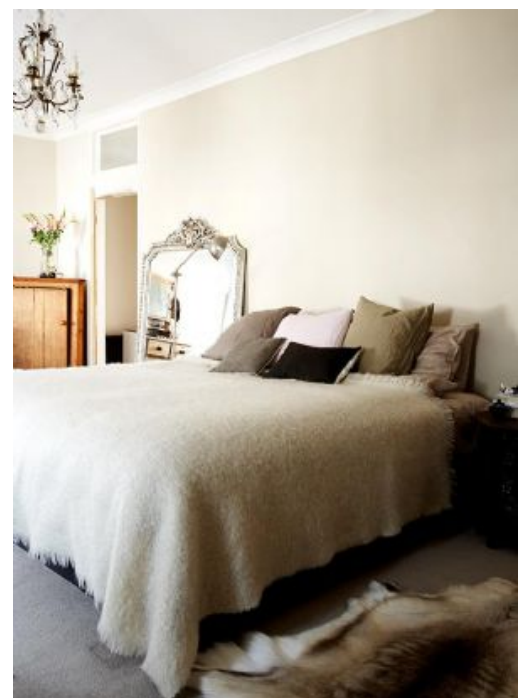
